

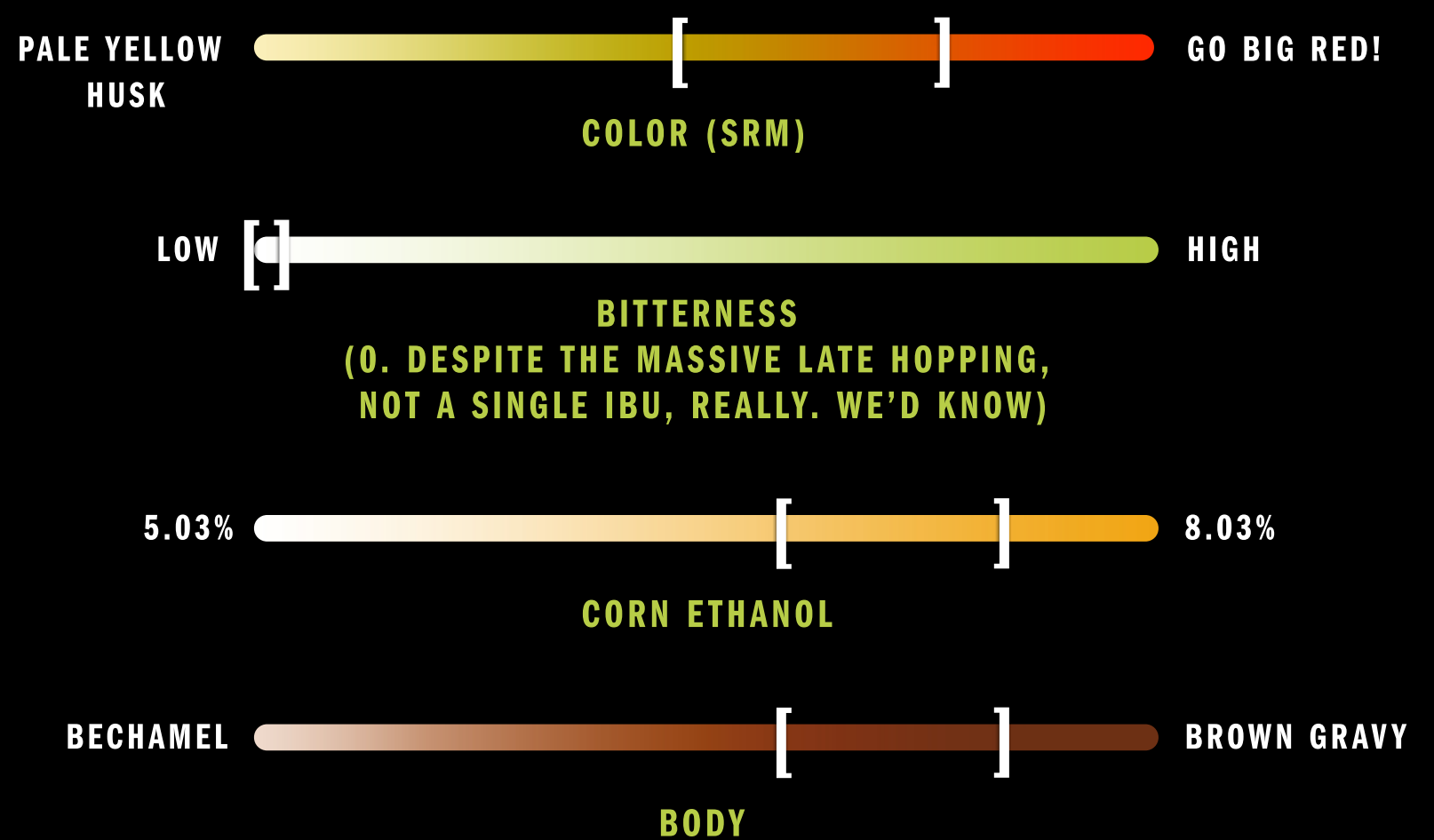
NE-Style IPA
